Hearing screenings will take place in Room HC-5 of the U.S. Capitol from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 18, 2006, for Members of Congress and Capitol Hill staff.

This event, hosted by the *Deaf and Hard of Hearing Alliance*, the *Hearing Industries Association*, the *American Speech-Language-Hearing Association*, the *American Academy of Audiology*, the *American Academy of Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgery*, the *American Tinnitus Association*, and the *International Hearing Society*, will include an Issues Forum and the opportunity to meet representatives of the deaf and hard of hearing community. Refreshments will be served from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Beginning at 4:00 p.m., the Issues Forum will examine key hearing health initiatives, including the newborn infant hearing screening through the reauthorization of the Early Hearing Detection and Intervention Act (H.R. 5250), and passage of the Hearing Aid Assistance Tax Credit Act (H.R. 414/S. 1060) that will help make hearing aid devices more accessible.

Over 31 million Americans experience hearing loss – a number that is expected to grow to 78 million in the coming years. Many are unaware that their hearing is no longer normal.
