

Switchless T-coil feature automatically switches on when a hearing aid compatible telephone



A **T-coil feature** that improves telephone use is available on INFINITI 3 ITE and BTE models.

A **full family of styles** includes the practically invisible Completely-in-the-Canal (CIC) model. In-the-Canal (ITC), Half Shell (HS), In-the-Ear (ITE) and Behind-the-Ear (BTE) models are also available.
