PREPARATION AND PLANNING

Before the first session, you should prepare your curriculum, publicize your program and establish ground rules

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Two Session Program

SESSION ONE

The goal of the first session is to help the group express their life experiences with hearing loss

SESSION TWO

The goal of the second session is to inform participants about different communication strategies they can employ

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Eight Session Program

SESSION THREE

In the third session, you should continue focusing on communication strategies

SESSION FOUR

Start addressing feelings and social stigmas associated with hearing loss and introduce the clear speech method

SESSION FIVE

Use this session to introduce participants to consumer organization and to continue working with difficult listening situations

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Eight Session Program

SESSION SIX

In this session, you can provide participants with information about hearing assistive technology

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Eight Session Program

SESSION SEVEN

Enable participants to advocate on their own behalf and prepare for emergencies

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
